Red ruby color, cherry, plums fragrance with light balsamic notes and spices on the nose, grows on the palate gently and smoothly, with a hint of vanilla taste. Nice and elegant finish. First vintage produced.

Production zone: Montorio – Verona

Soil: Limestone

Bottles Produced: 5100

Varieties: 40% Corvina, 40% Corvinone, 15% Rondinella, 5% Molinara

Exposure: West and South West

Vinification: In the late September the grapes are hand-picked from a specific vineyard called Campo Bianco, maceration on the skin in a stainless-steel tank until fermentation is over

A microfiltration is done before bottling

Aging: French oak barrel for 1 year
